 - 3. Graduate Student Event Attendance
 - a. We allocate 10% of our budget to USG for campus-wide events **USG has allotted \$3500 to cover DACA student fees, but does not include graduate students, but GAPSA can cover % is supposed to be based on our attendance**
 - b. Event Attendance - Overall: 8.09% - **We should not give them 10% next year based on this attendance. If we give them nothing, graduate students are treated as faculty/staff at events. Saves GAPSA \$90,000 a year (~\$10,000 per association). Another option is backpay for events after attendance is taken (but attendance is taken on a lag year, something to keep in mind).**
